Main content

The course covers the following main topics:

- Behaviour associated with projects and how to handle change processes.
- Project conflicts both upwards, downwards and outwards.
- Leading the project towards impact and value for the organisation.
- Follow-up in terms of progress, risks, economy, quality and impact.
- Active use of the business case.
- Negotiations with key stakeholders.
- Co-creation and implementation strategies.
- Power and influence in the project’s decision processes and implementation phase.

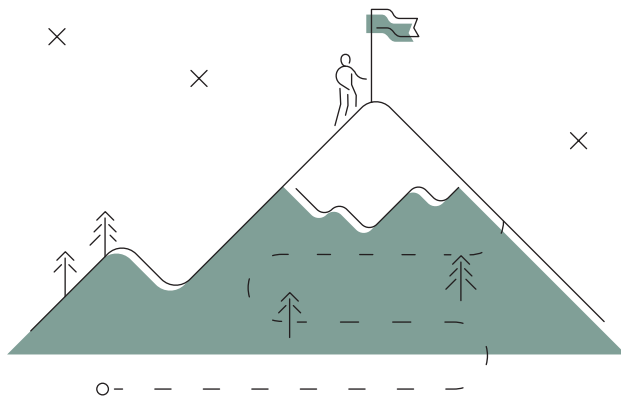
