Target group

Main content

The course covers the following main topics:

- Developing followship in the project (how to get people to join you).

- Your strengths in the role as project manager and your personal development areas.
- How to make use of your personal preferences in relation to tasks such as organising, change, analysis and collaboration in projects.
- How to conduct dialogues that get your project participants on board in the project and dialogues that help develop them further as the project progresses.
- How to strengthen relations between the project and its surroundings (systemic perspective).
- Effective communication between you, your project participants and project stakeholders to avoid talking at cross-purposes.
- Storytelling as a means to strengthen project progress and the commitment of the project team.

- Have onboarding dialogues and discussions with your project participants in a motivating and engaging manner.
- Target your communication about the project so that your messages “stick” and promote commitment.

- Understand and utilise your own and your project participants’ different work styles when working under pressure.
- Create meaningful stories to ensure stakeholder commitment to the project.
